

Copper Basin Dress Code

- No muscle shirts or tank tops, entire sleeves are required
- All shirts worn must show no stomach skin when arms are fully extended into the air (undershirts can be worn to remedy this)
- No see through tops
- Printed tees as well as other clothing articles cannot show profanity, nudity, drug and alcohol references, or any other inappropriate content
- No holes in jeans 4 inches above the knee that show skin
- Shorts can be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee when standing
- No leggings, spandex, or bike shorts
- No open toed shoes
- With these rules in mind counselors are also allowed to dress code campers at their discretion for special cases
- When dress coded campers are expected to comply with counselors and go change into something deemed appropriate by said counselor
- If for some reason a camper comes without any appropriate clothing, a counselor or the director will take measures to accommodate them (most likely with basketball shorts and generic t shirts from walmart)

Formal Night Dress Code

- Dresses and skirts cannot be shorter than 4 inches above the knee when sitting
- No low cut dresses or tops
- No open back dresses or tops
- No open shoulder dresses or tops
- No see through tops
- No bodycon dresses
- Case by case decisions will be made by counselors or the Director
